MEMORANDUM FOR ALL DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE EMPLOYEES

SUBJECT: 2013 Combined Federal Campaign

Thank you for your role in the Department's efforts to conduct a successful and energetic solicitation on behalf of the charities which rely upon the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC).

Department of Defense employees are advised that CFC campaign activities in the Continental United States are indefinitely suspended. Upon legal review, these activities are not excepted from furlough nor are they appropriate activities under the Pay Our Military Act.

Until such time as we have a Continuing Resolution or congressionally-approved appropriation, please postpone all CFC events, training, and fund-raisers. During this interim period, if employees still want to initiate their pledge through myPay, that option remains open in the jurisdictions previously approved.

We look forward to a quick return and the resumption of a vigorous campaign to help those people who rely upon local, national and international charities. Further guidance will be forwarded accordingly.
