

July 2014 Monthly Military Justice Update

The following military justice actions occurred during July and parts of June 2014 on Joint Base Lewis-McChord:

Courts-Martial:

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of possession and receipt of obscene visual depictions of minors engaged in sexual conduct. He was sentenced to 60 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.

Summary Court-Martial:

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of wrongful use and distribution of marijuana in violation of Art 112a of the UCMJ. He was sentenced to 14 days confinement, reduction to E-2, and a reprimand.

Non-Judicial Punishments (Article 15s):

- A Team McChord SrA was found to have used marijuana in violation of Art 112a of the UCMJ. He received a suspended reduction to E-3, forfeiture of \$250.00 pay per month for two months, and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord A1C was found to have violated a lawful general order by ingesting spice in violation of Art 92 of the UCMJ. He was also found to have used marijuana in violation of Art 112a of the UCMJ. He received a reduction to E-2 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord A1C was found to have used marijuana in violation of Art 112a of the UCMJ and to have made a false official statement in violation of Art 107 of the UCMJ. He received a reduction to E-2, suspended forfeitures of \$858.00, 45 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of drunken driving. He received 14 days extra duties, reduction to E-2, and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of drunken driving. He received 14 days extra duties, reduction to E-2, a reprimand, and forfeitures of \$858.

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of making a false official statement. She received 2 days of extra duties, reduction to E-3, and a reprimand.

Discharges:

- A Team McChord A1C received an Honorable service discharge characterization for Unsatisfactory Performance, specifically a failure to progress in military training.
- A Team McChord SSgt received a General service discharge characterization for Drug Abuse and a Pattern of Misconduct.
- A Team McChord A1C was discharged with a General service characterization for drug abuse.
- A Team McChord SrA was discharged with a General service characterization for drug abuse.
- A Team McChord A1C was discharged with a General service characterization for drug abuse and a pattern of misconduct.
