

Who is the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT)?

The International Union of Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT) of the United States and Canada is a multi-craft union whose members are commercial/residential painters, industrial painters, floor coverers, glaziers/glassworkers, drywall finishers/tapers and sign/display convention workers. There are approximately 140,000 highly skilled IUPAT members who belong to 33 district councils, which include over 300 individual local unions across North America. The IUPAT has multi-craft training centers across the United States and Canada who provide the highest quality training in the industry, which includes standardized instruction and curriculum with professional trainers, extensive journey worker continual training and certification programs. Our IUPAT members work in all types of weather and elevated heights and we are looking for the best the military has to offer to join our ranks. The International Union of Painters and Allied Trades is the start of a lifetime.

What is the Painters & Allied Trades Veterans Program (PAT-VP)?

- An education training program that promises skilled trades training in the industrial coatings and applications career
- An education training program that provides intense accelerated training in a multi-craft union.
- Designed for Active-Duty Servicemembers transitioning from military service
- Is a free 4 week, full-time training program
- Participants in the program are assigned to the program as their place of duty for the 4 weeks. The classroom instruction/training is held at the Army Education Centers on JBLM and the hands-on training is held at IUPAT District Council 5 Training Center, 6770 E. Marginal Way SE Seattle, WA
- Upon successful completion of the training program, graduates will earn a Coating Applicator Specialist Level One Certification and are placed in a paid 4-year IUPAT apprenticeship program. Participants will be credited one training semester with assisted job placement and a career with the IUPAT. Once in an IUPAT apprenticeship program, participants will begin to accrue college credits toward an associate degree.

What are the requirements for application?

Must Have:

- Be A TRANSITIONING Servicemember with a Separation/Retirement date one month either side of the class end date
- Secure Command authorization to participate.
- Provide a copy of your Army Enlisted Record Brief (ERB, Army only) or copy of Records Review from Virtual Military Personnel Flight (vMPF, Air Force only)
- Receive an Honorable Discharge (*does not include General-Under Honorable Conditions*)
- Have a High School diploma or GED
- Have correctable vision to 20/20
- Be able to stand for long periods of time
- Be able to lift 75 pounds
- ASVAB Scores: MM 95 or higher/GT 90 or higher (Army only)
- ASVAB Composite General Score of 50 or higher, Mechanical Score of 40 or higher; Electrical Score of 28 or higher (Air Force only)
- A valid driver license
- Resume

- College Degree or Credits
